Legal Fees:	\$11,000
Estimate based on costs for representation for parents for GSA contract, parentage process, and estate planning (simple will) and for representation for surrogate for GSA contract, parentage process, and estate planning (living will and health care proxy).	
Travel Costs:	\$3,000 - \$7,000
Estimate based on airfare, hotel, and per diem for surrogate and companion for two trips to IVF clinic: (1) medical screening and (2) embryo transfer.

Surrogate Automatic Compensation

Base Compensation:	\$60,000 - \$75,000+
Varies based on surrogate experience and health insurance coverage.	
Miscellaneous Expense Allowance:	\$300/month (\$350 for twins)
Paid from contract signing through one month postpartum. Typically 14 months' duration or \$4,200 total. Covers incidental expenses such as local travel, parking, postage, prenatal vitamins and non-prescription medications.	
Medical Clearance Bonus:	\$500

Surrogate Potential Compensation (cont.)

Lost Wages:	<i>Varies</i>
Gross lost wages are paid as needed for physician-ordered bed rest, required travel, hospital stays, and postpartum recovery up to six (6) weeks for vaginal delivery and eight (8) weeks for c-section (without doctor's note). A spouse/partner's lost wages are capped at 10 days.	
Child Care Expenses:	Up to \$150/day
Paid as needed for additional childcare expenses (not normal arrangements). Available under same circumstances as lost wages.	
Pet Boarding Expenses:	Up to \$40/day
Additional Housekeeping Expenses:	\$80/week
Paid as needed for physician-ordered bed rest occurring prior to 34 weeks' pregnant.

IVF expenses can vary widely based on many factors, including but not limited to, (1) need for embryo creation, (2) number of transfers, (3) choice to conduct preimplantation genetic testing, (4) cryopreservation costs, (5) specific medication protocol used for surrogate (and egg donor, if needed), (6) specific procedures used in embryo creation or transfer; and (7) applicable insurance coverage and employer-sponsored benefits.
